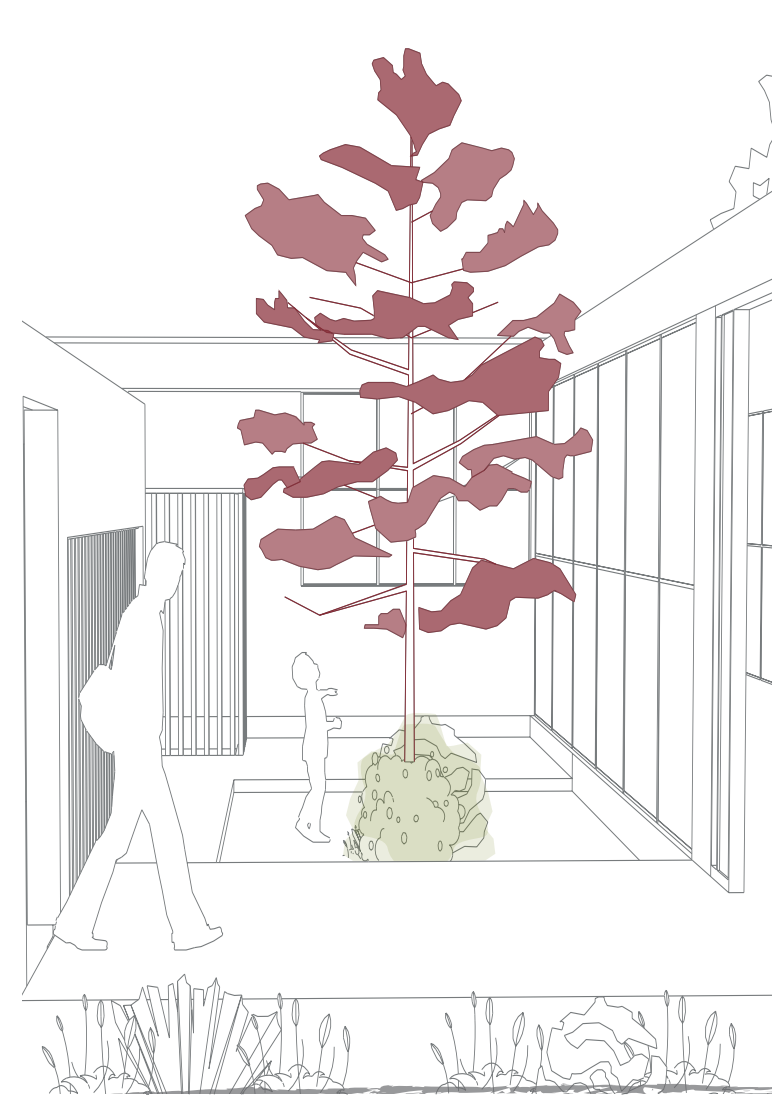

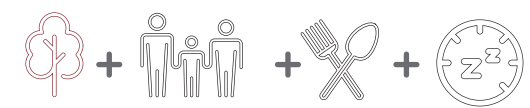
Site Diagram



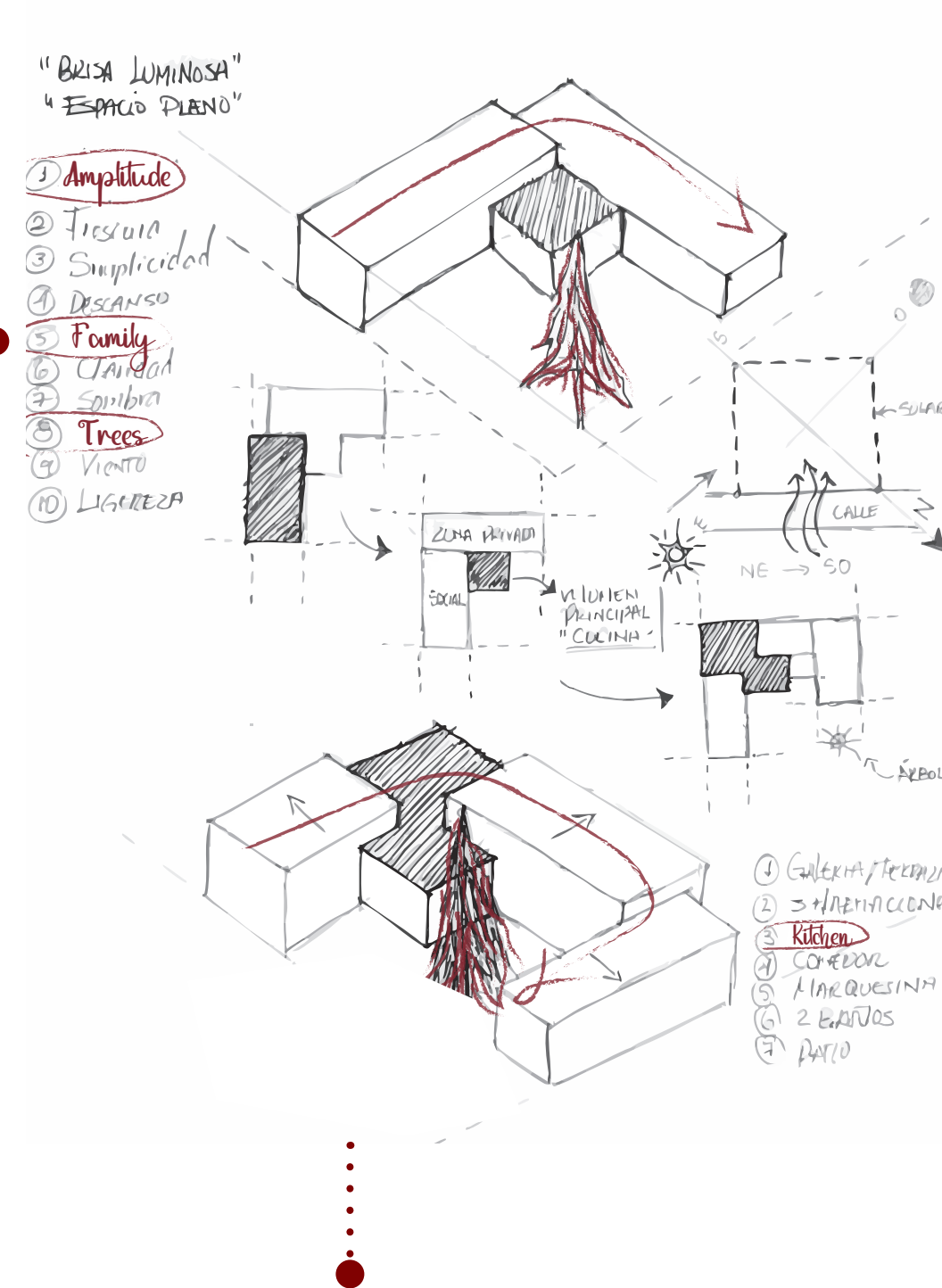

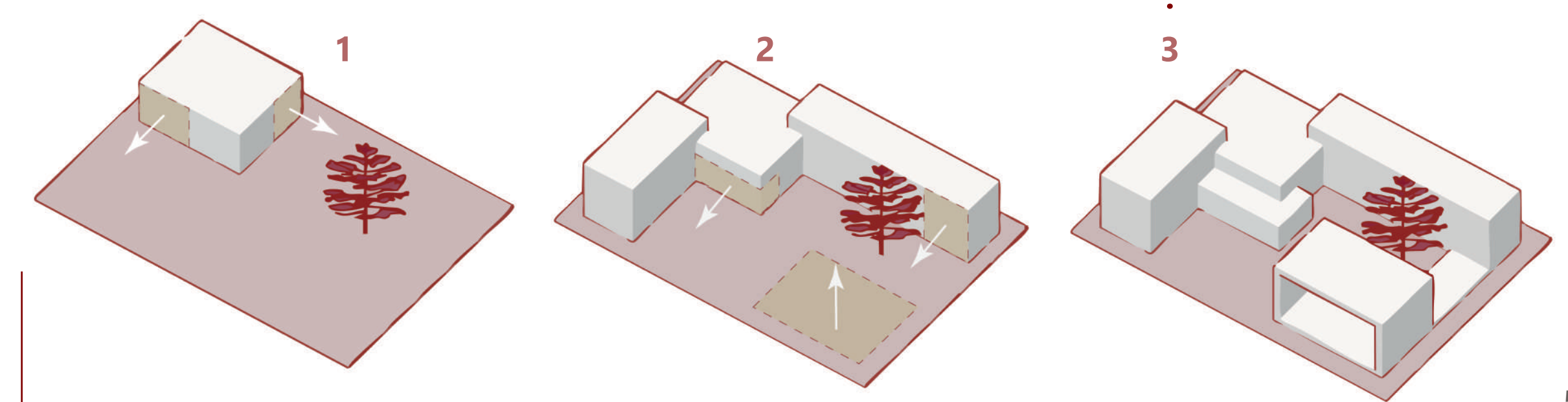

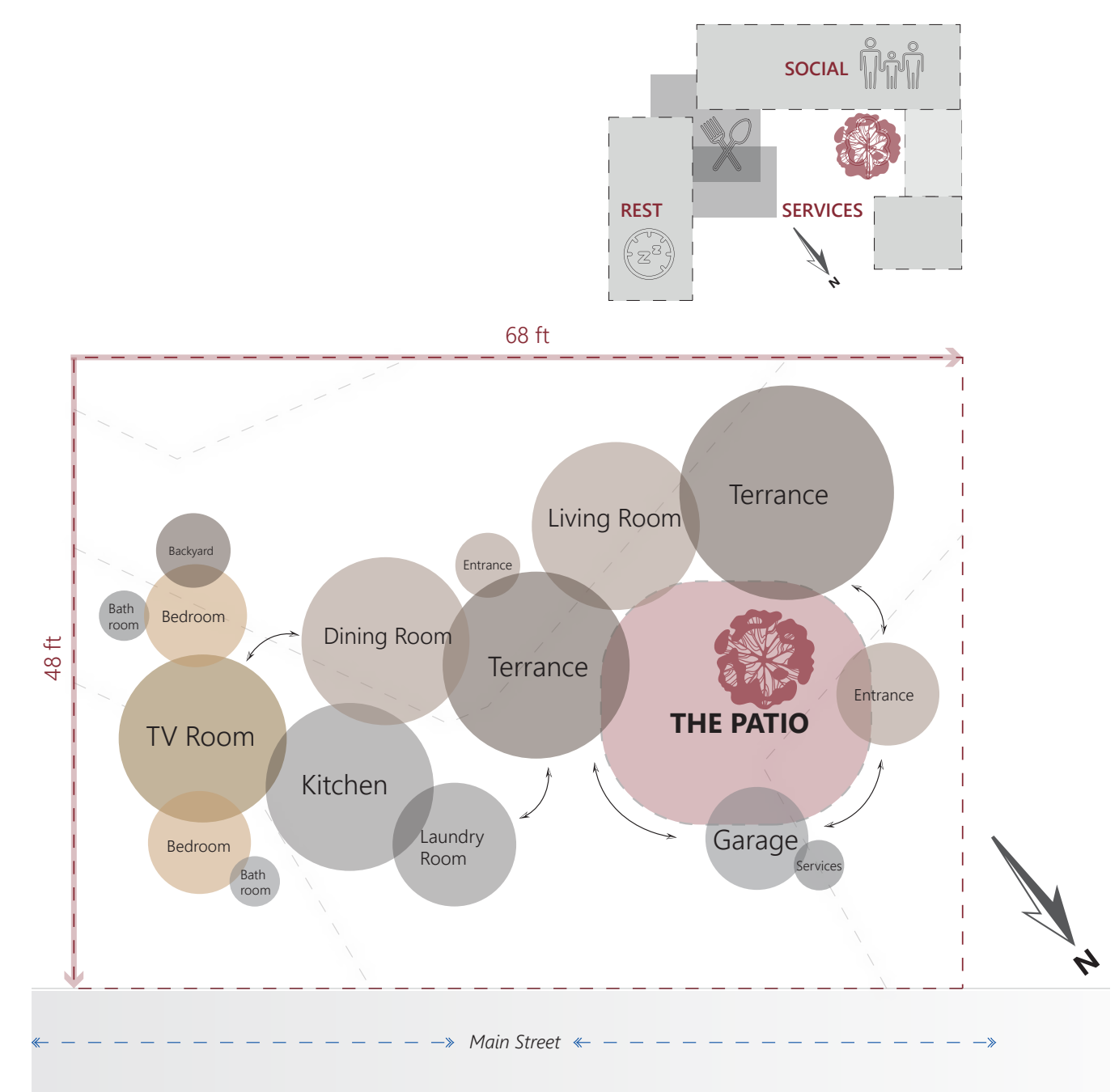

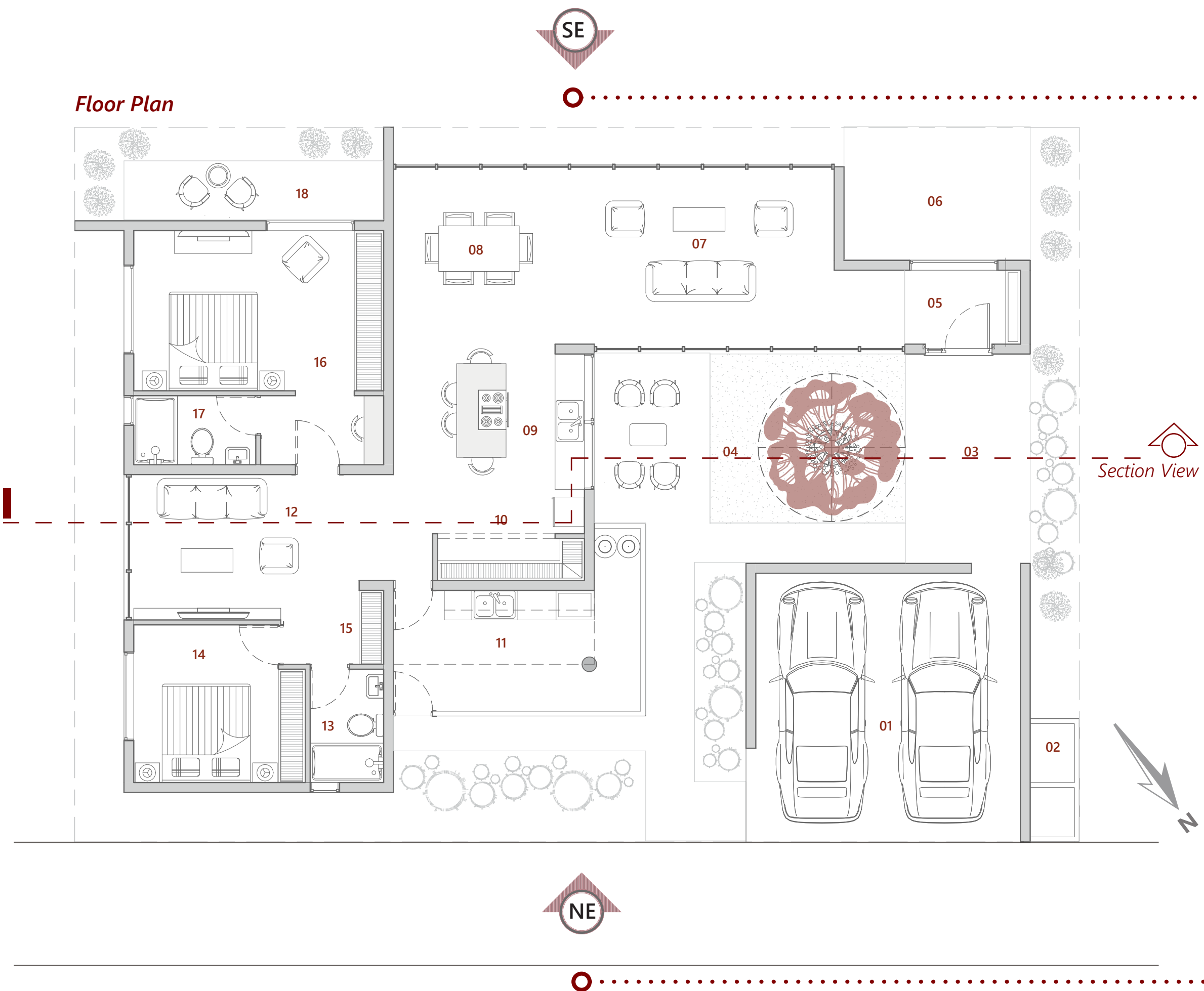
Zoning Diagram & Space Planning



This project focused on designing a climate responsive single family courtyard house tailored to the daily routines, budget, and priorities of a three person family. The main challenge was to create a compact and economical layout that would feel spacious, fresh, and naturally lit, while responding to strong winds and existing planting.

My role included developing the architectural concept, defining the volumetric strategy around a central courtyard, and organizing the program to support everyday activities such as cooking, washing, resting, and family gathering. I also produced the full set of architectural drawings, volumetric studies, and visual material used to communicate the design intent.

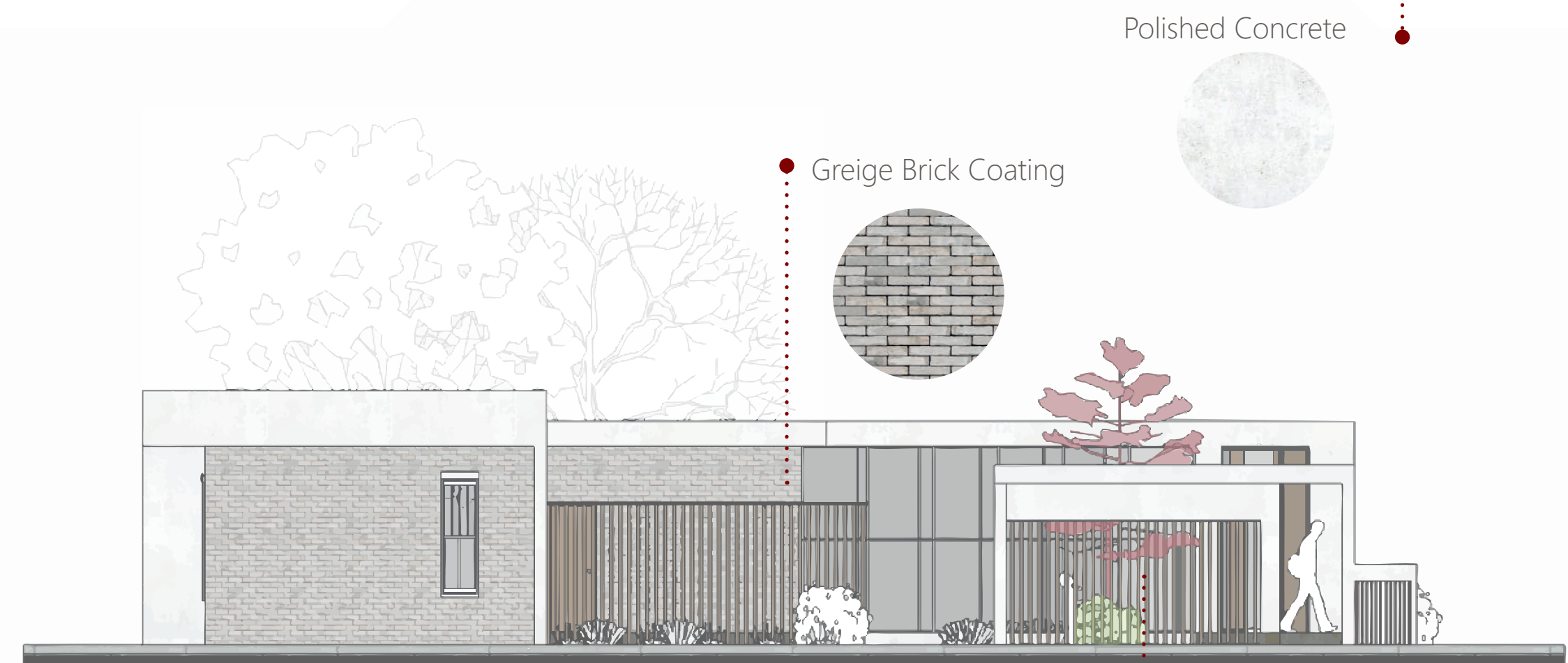
Floor Plan

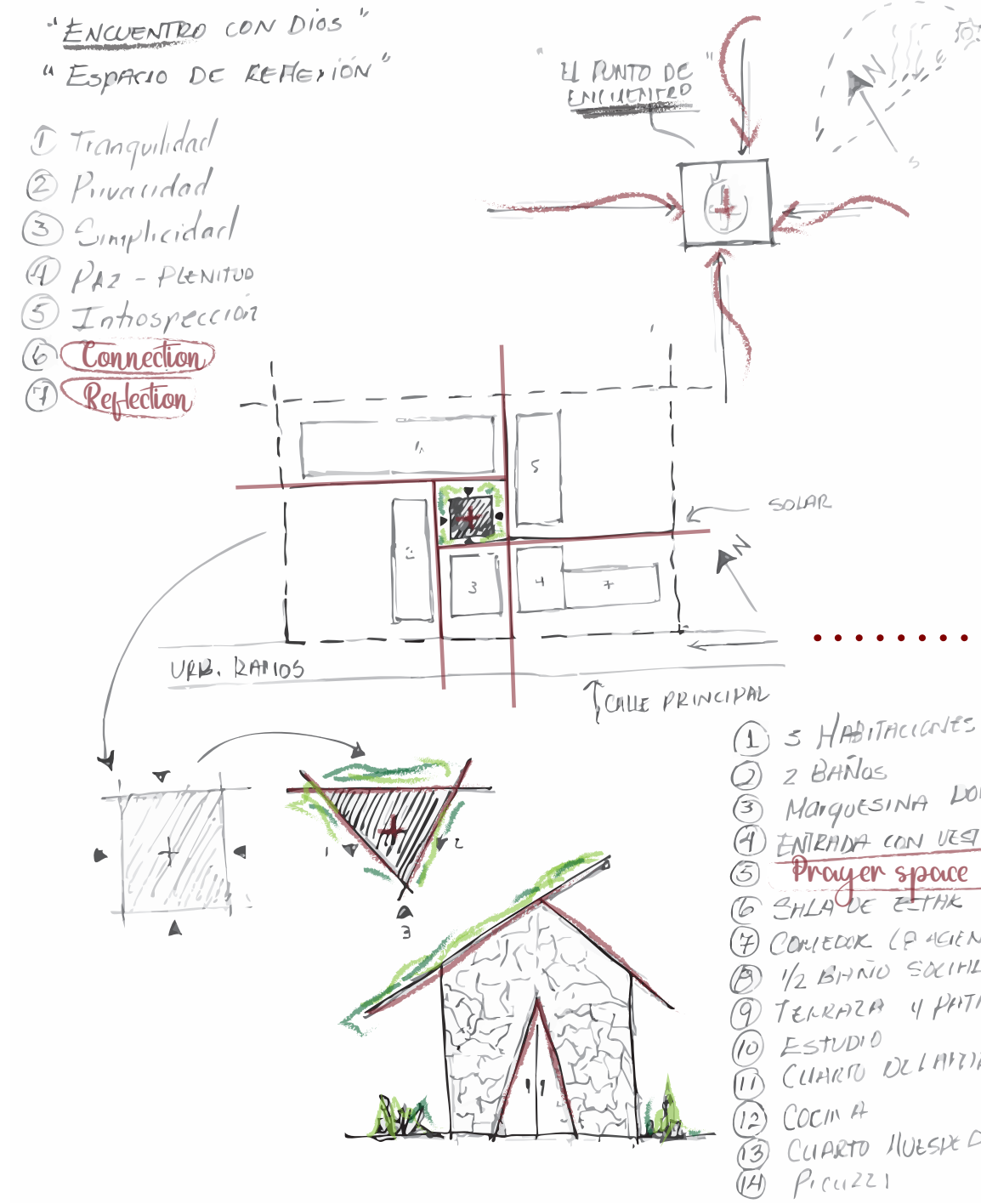

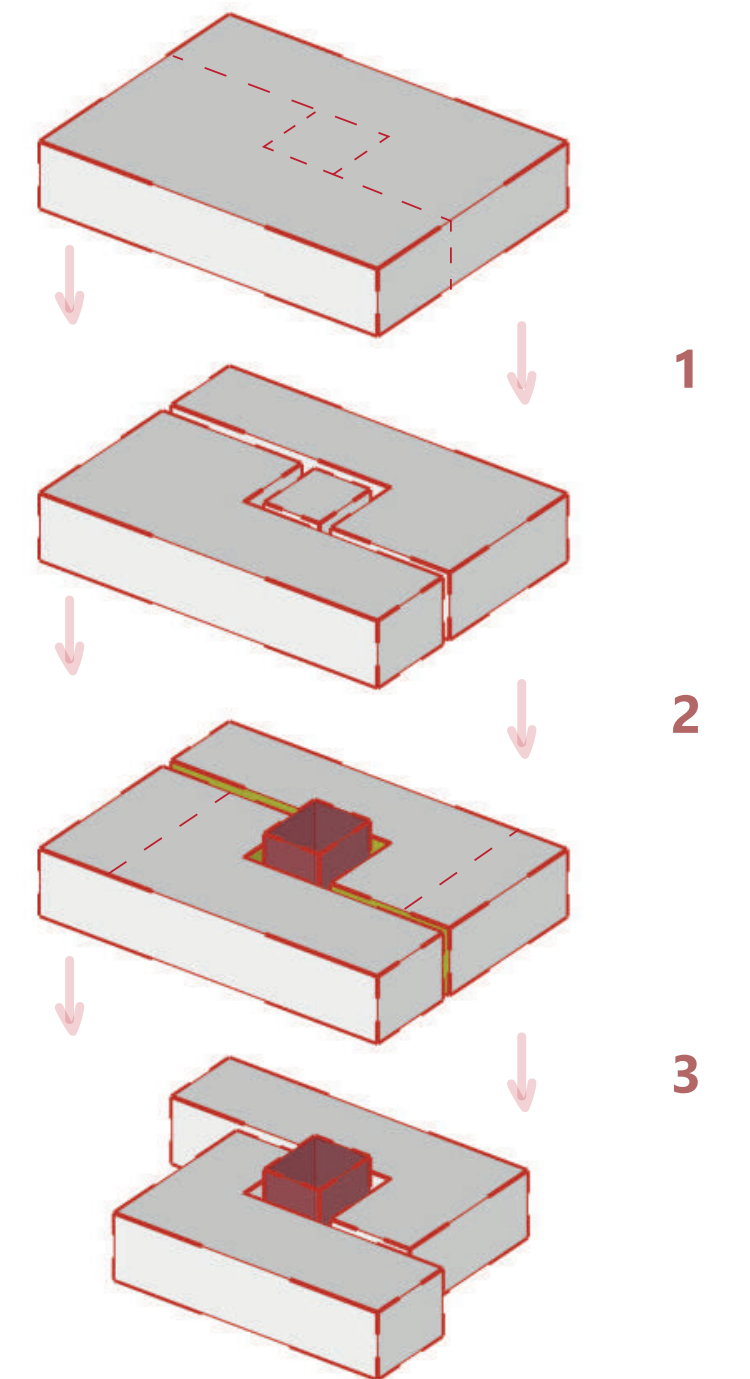

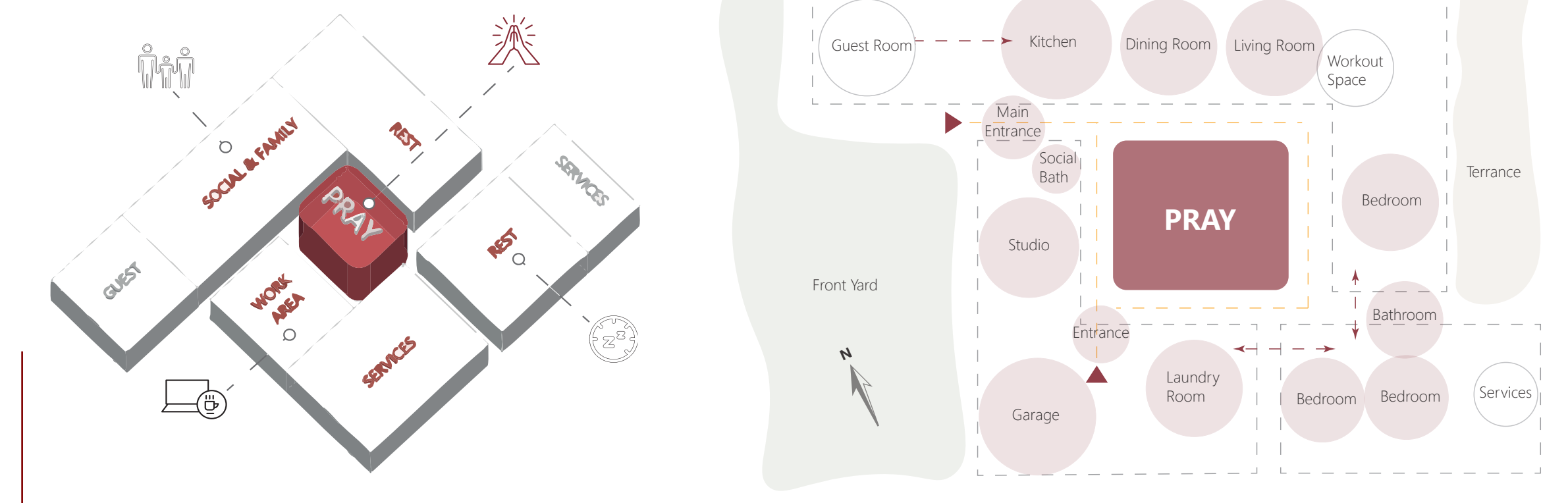

Zoning Diagram & Space Planning



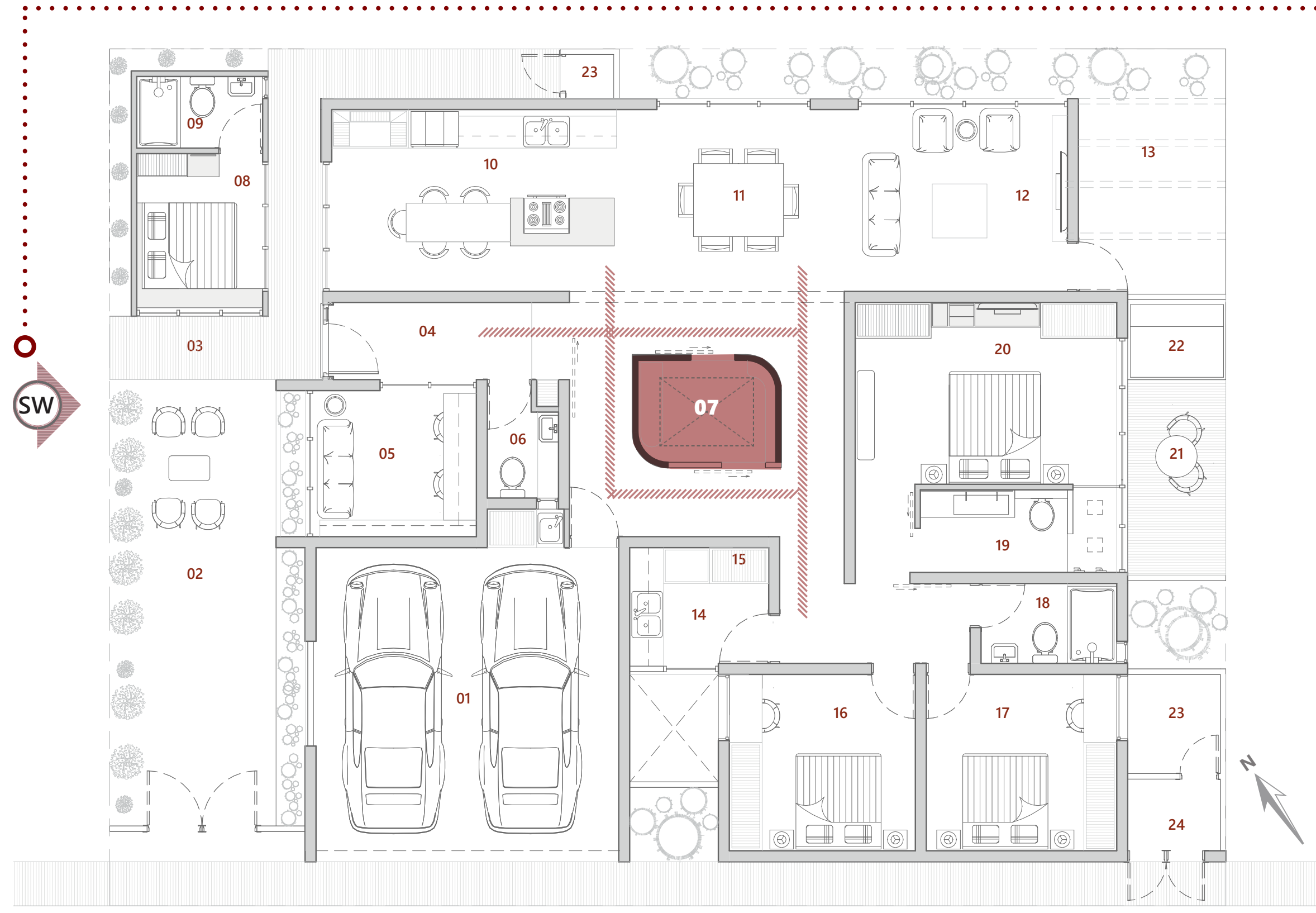
Main Concept & Family needs



Conceived as a home that prioritizes family connection, privacy, and shared moments of reflection, this single-family gathering house responds directly to the values and daily rhythms of its users. The main challenge was to balance the collective space for prayer and everyday interaction with quiet areas for rest and work from home, while maintaining natural ventilation, daylight, and a strong sense of enclosure and contemplation.

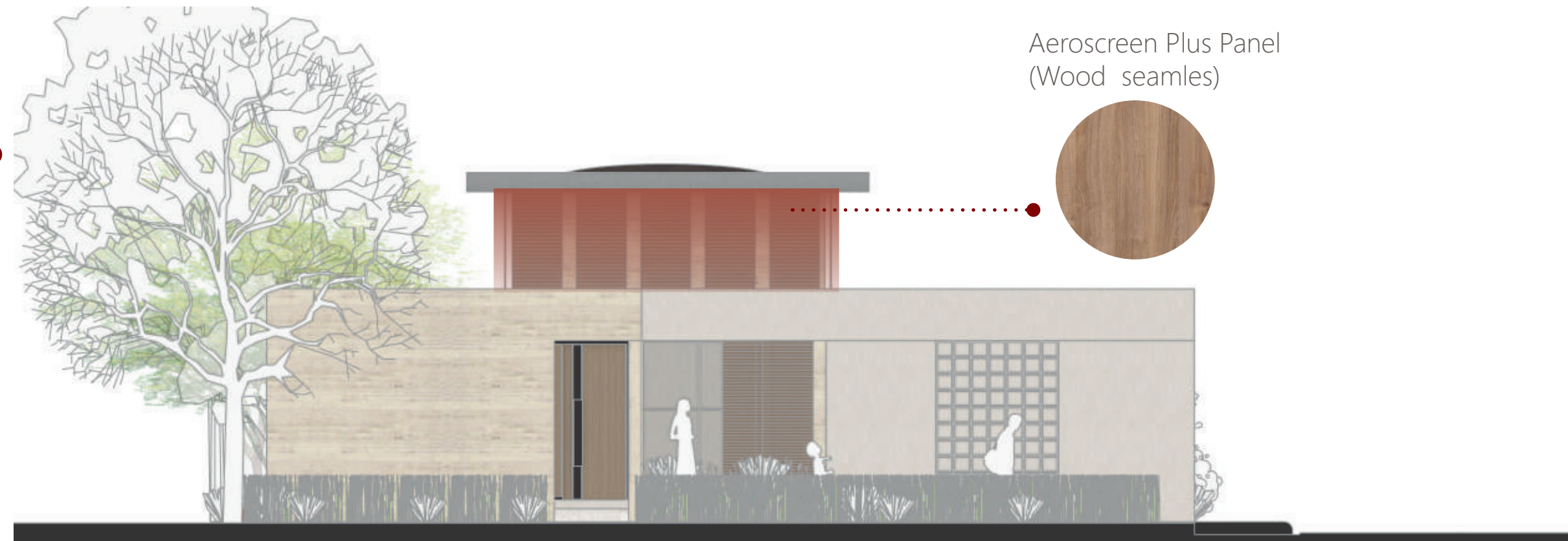

I also produced the full set of architectural drawings, spatial studies, and visual material used to communicate the design intent.

Floor Plan

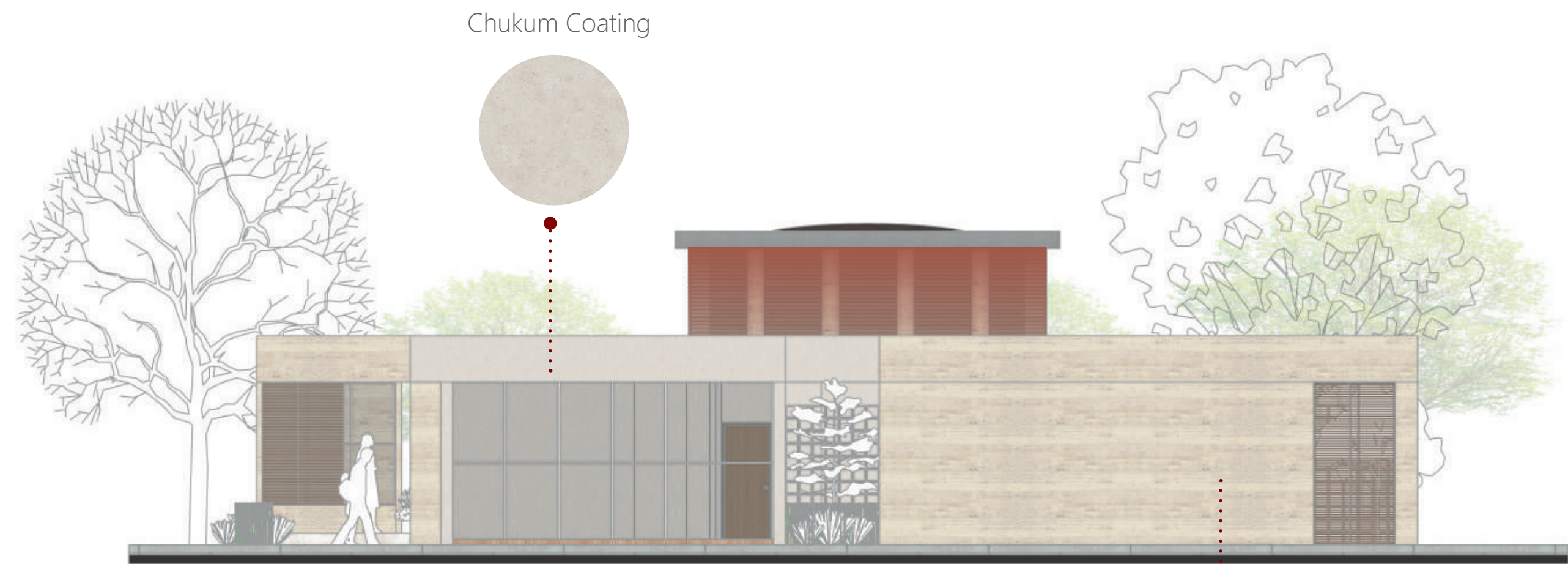

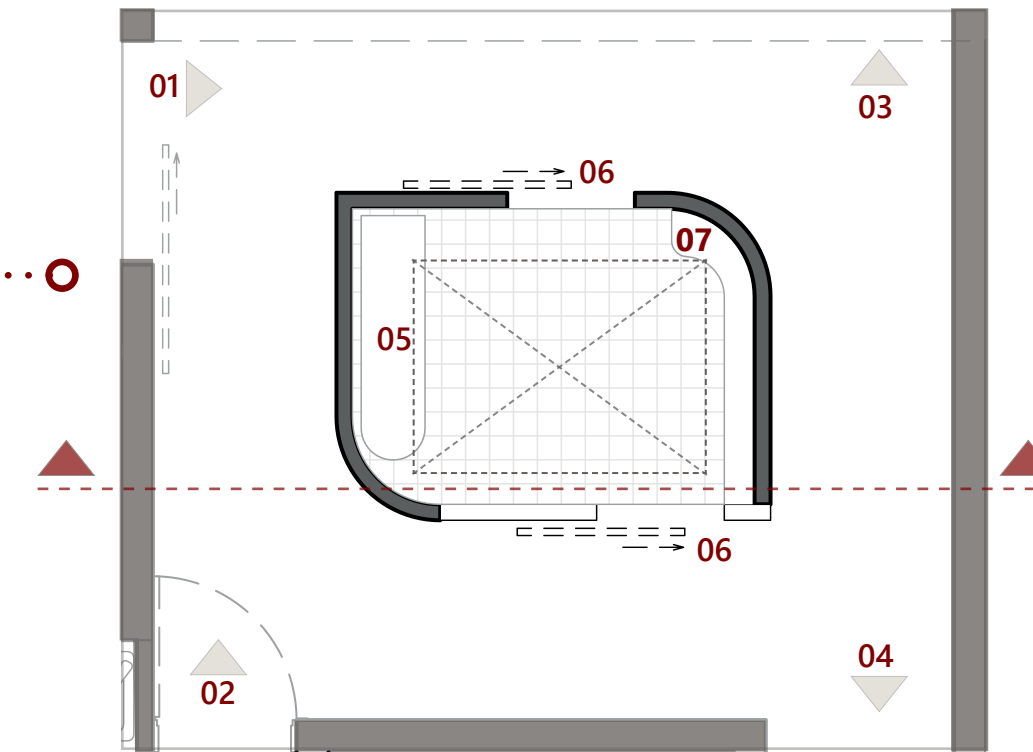

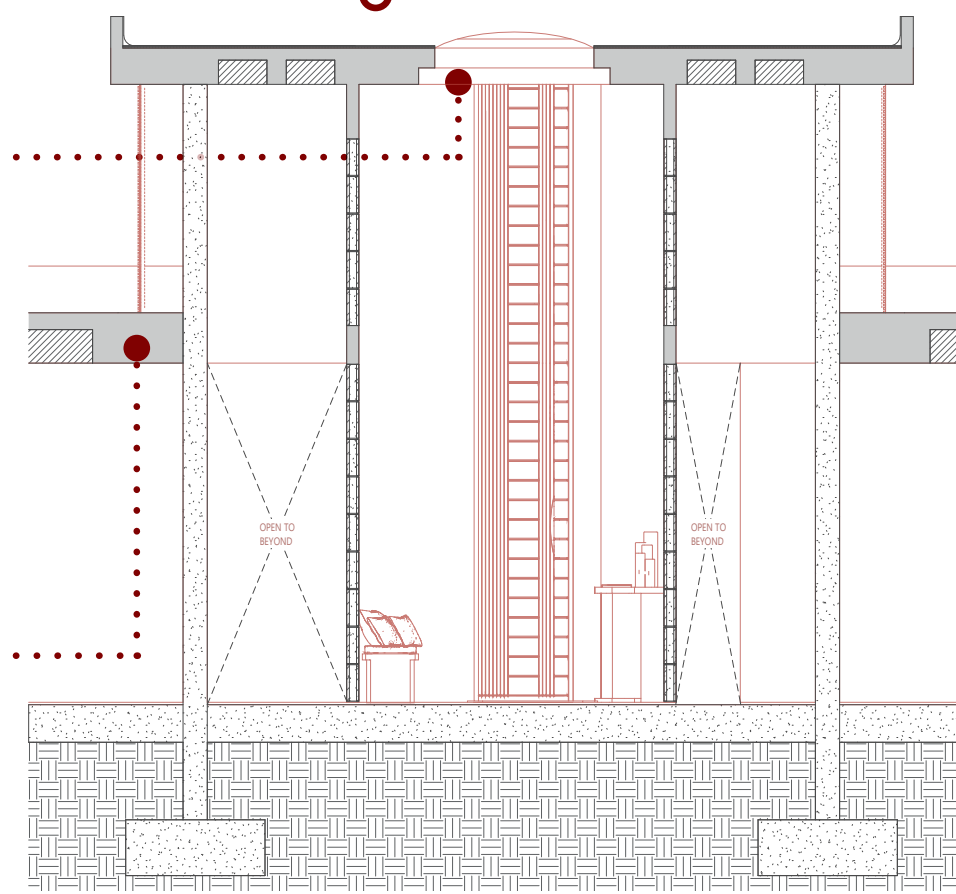
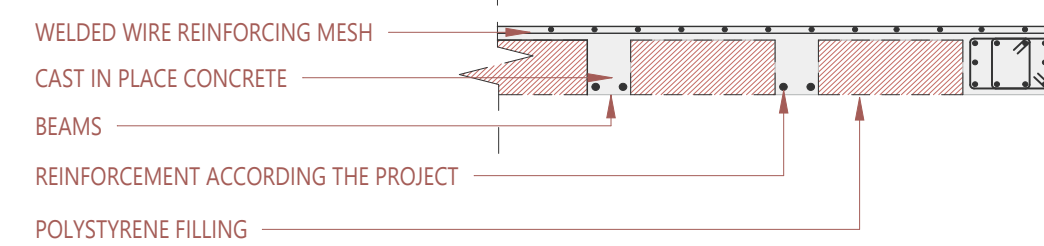
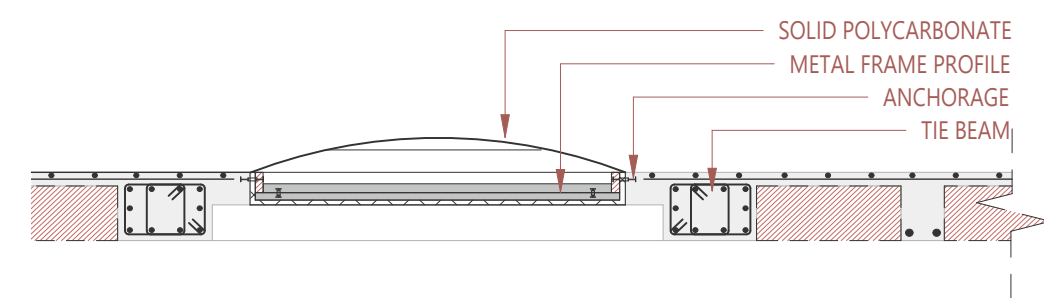


Axonometric Section View

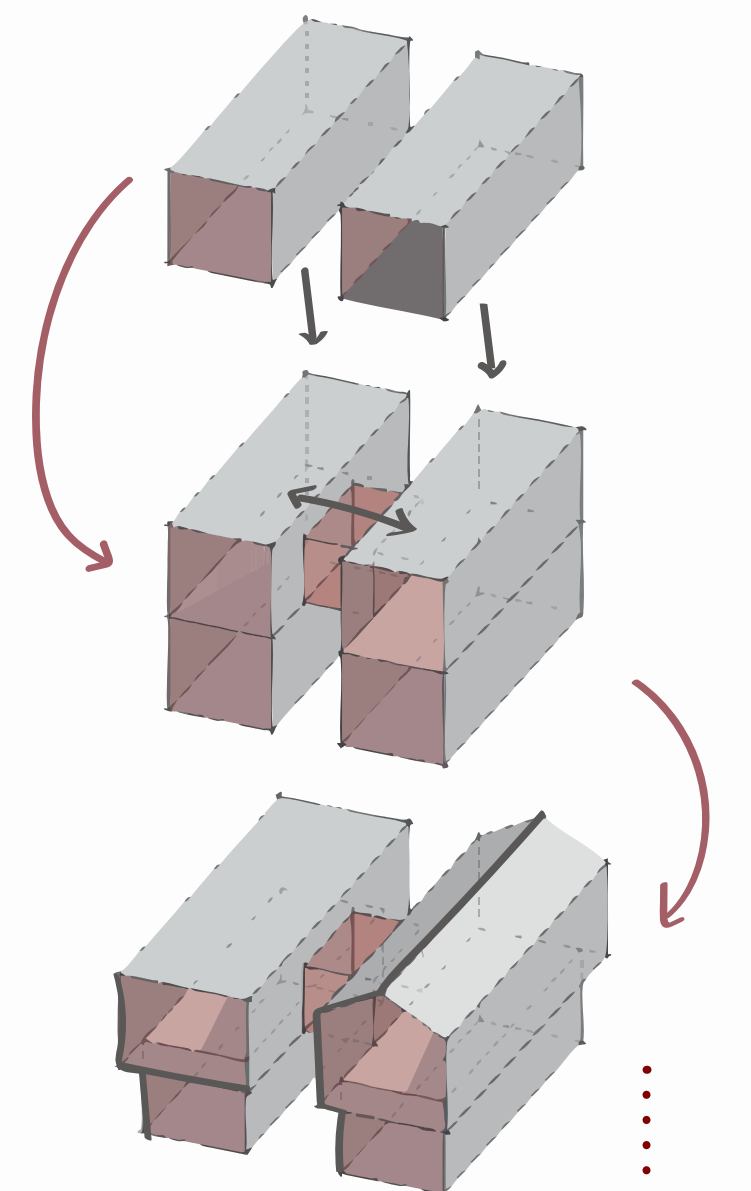

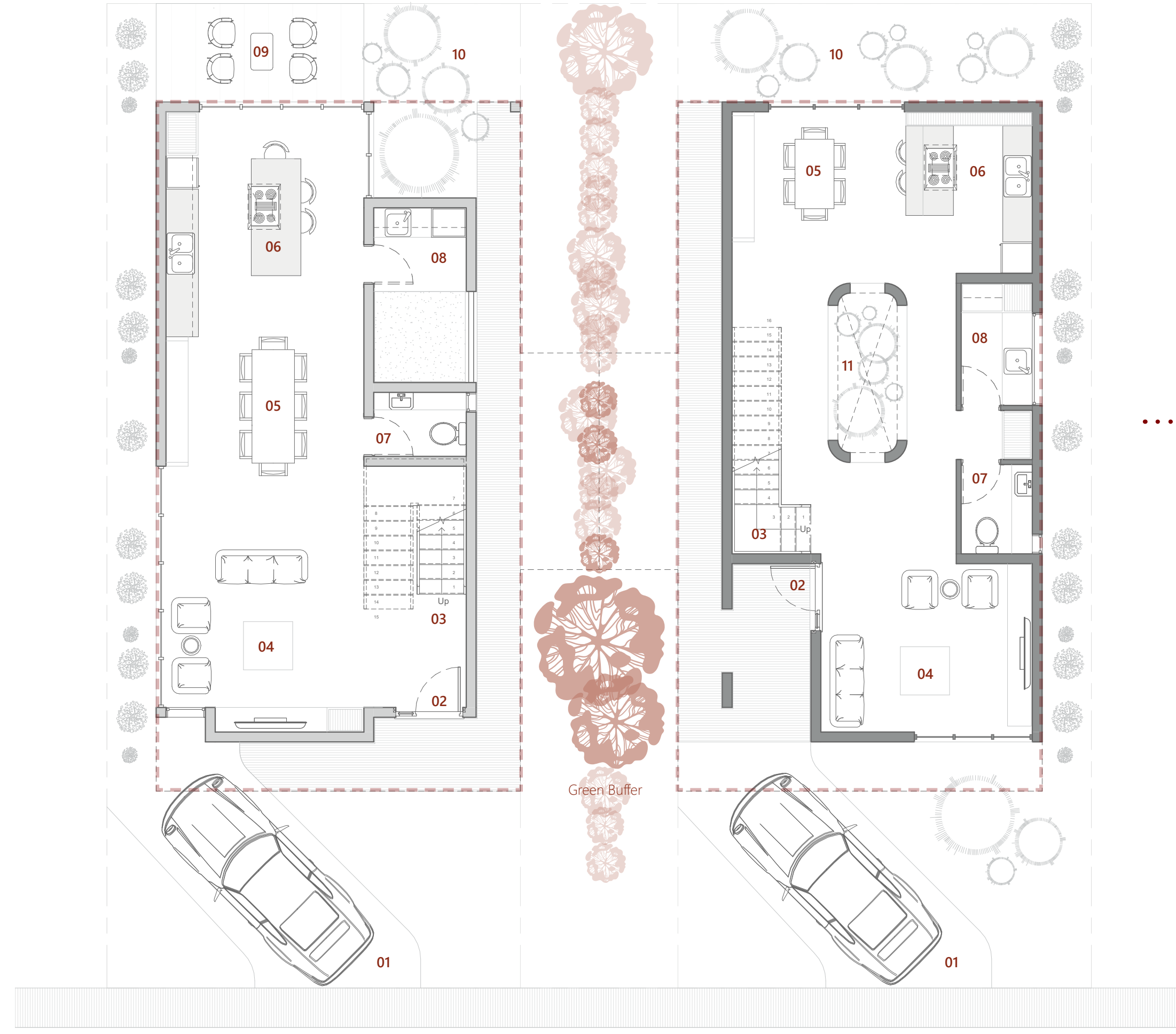
Zoning Diagram & Space Planning



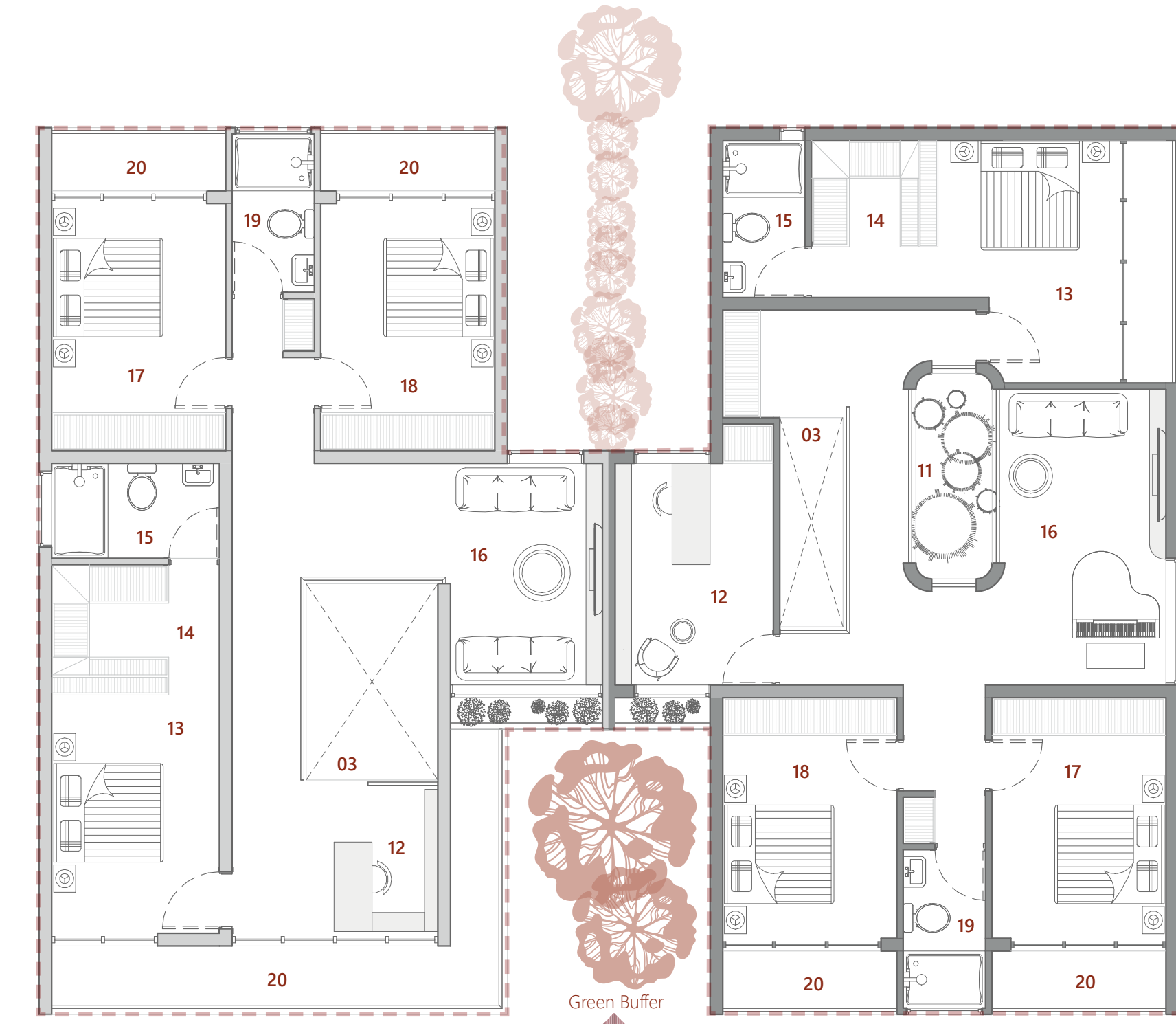

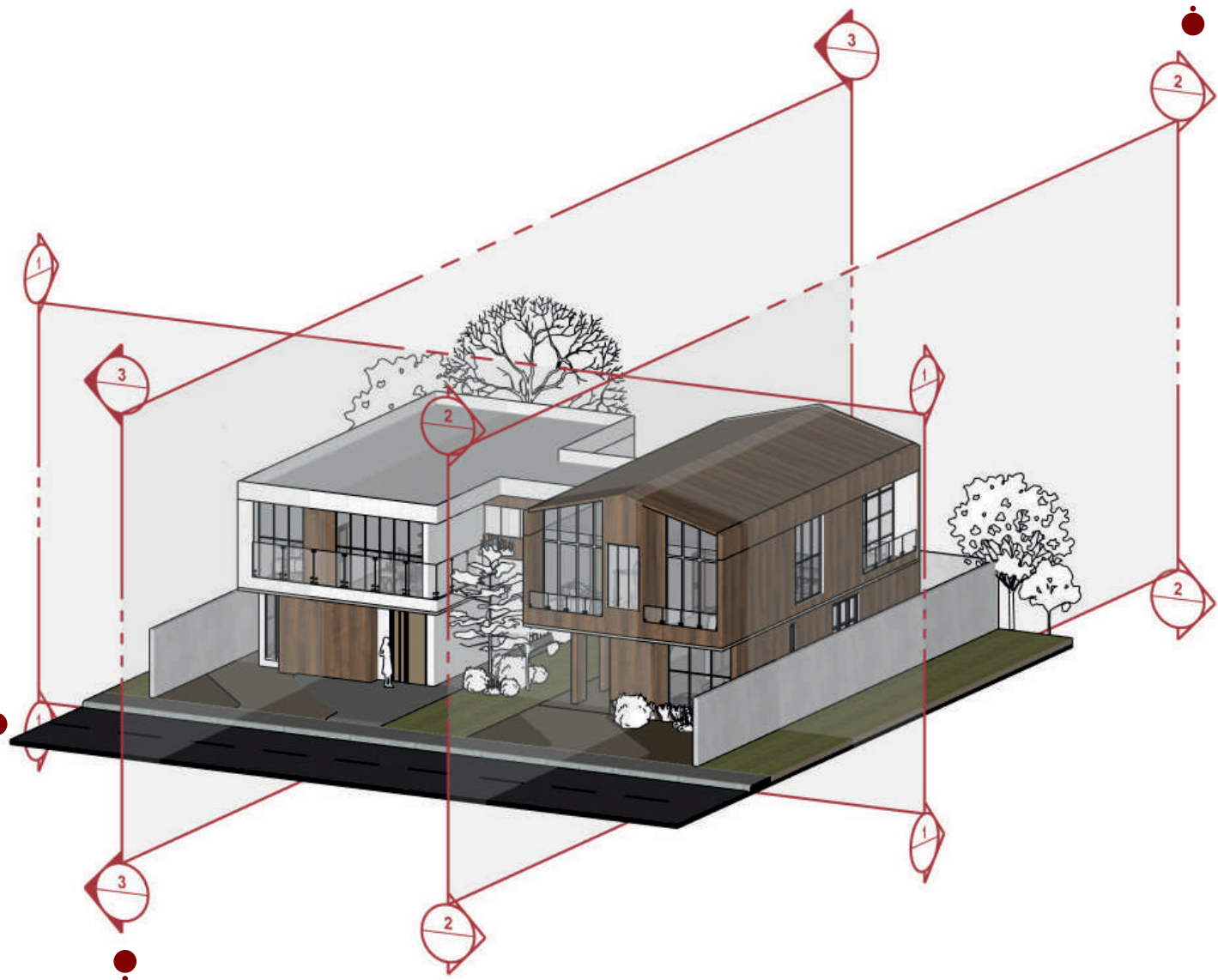

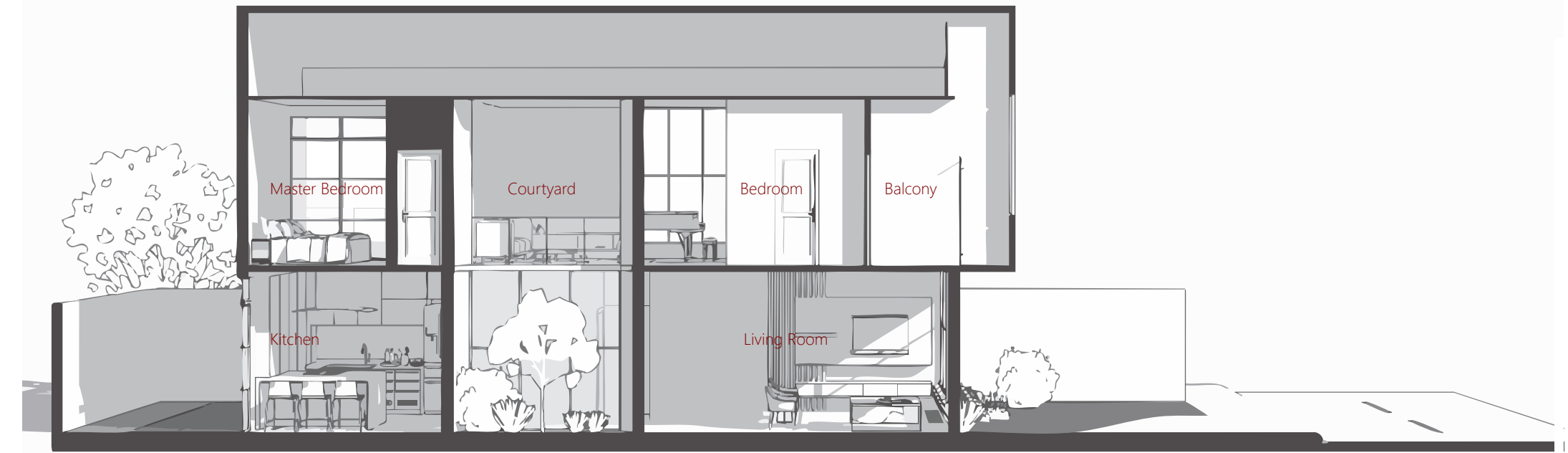

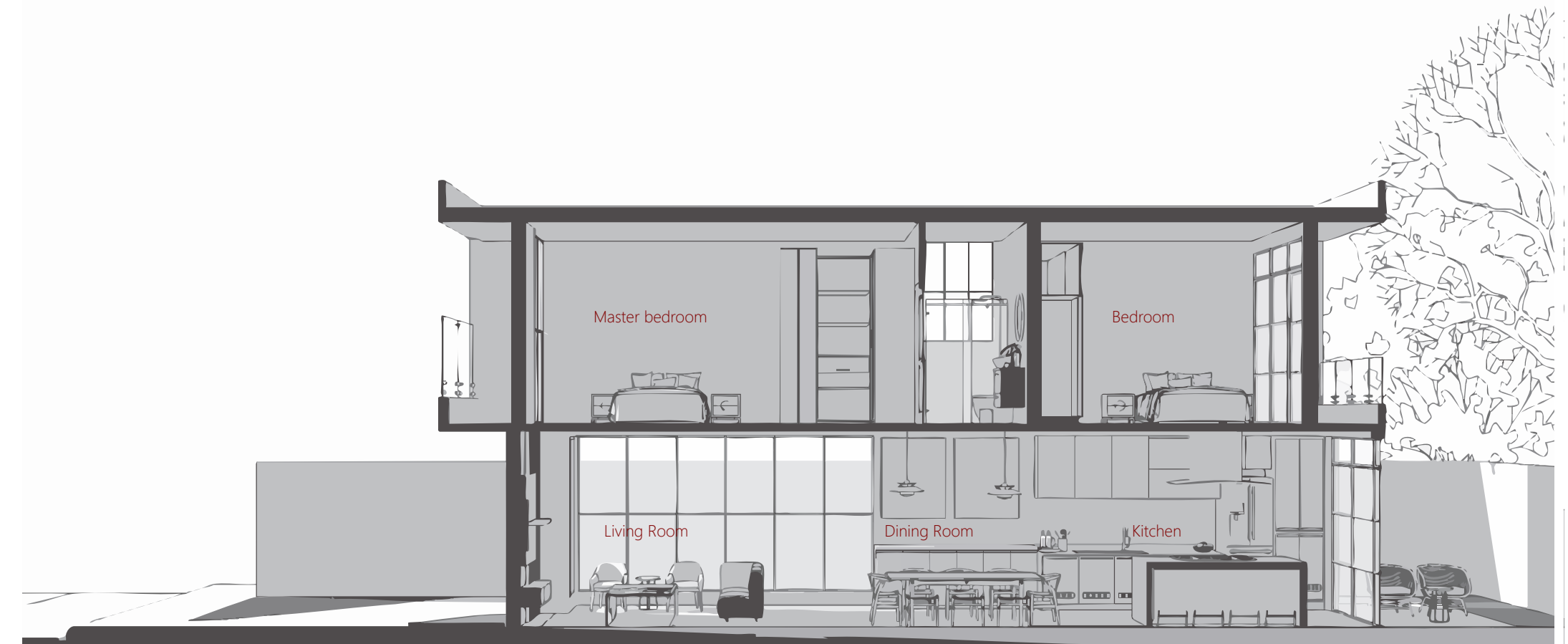
