## Abstract

This residence in Guanacaste, Costa Rica, is conceived to blend architecture with its natural surroundings. Designed with open, fluid spaces that frame lush vegetation and expansive views, the project emphasizes a seamless transition between indoors and outdoors.

Most of the living and social spaces are organized on the first floor, with private bedrooms and terraces on the second. A large terrace with an infinity pool serves as the heart of the design, connecting nearly every space to the landscape. The layout also incorporates guest accommodations and a private employee area, ensuring comfort and privacy.

The project reflects a refined, modern lifestyle rooted in its environment—offering residents an experience of living closely with nature while enjoying contemporary comfort.

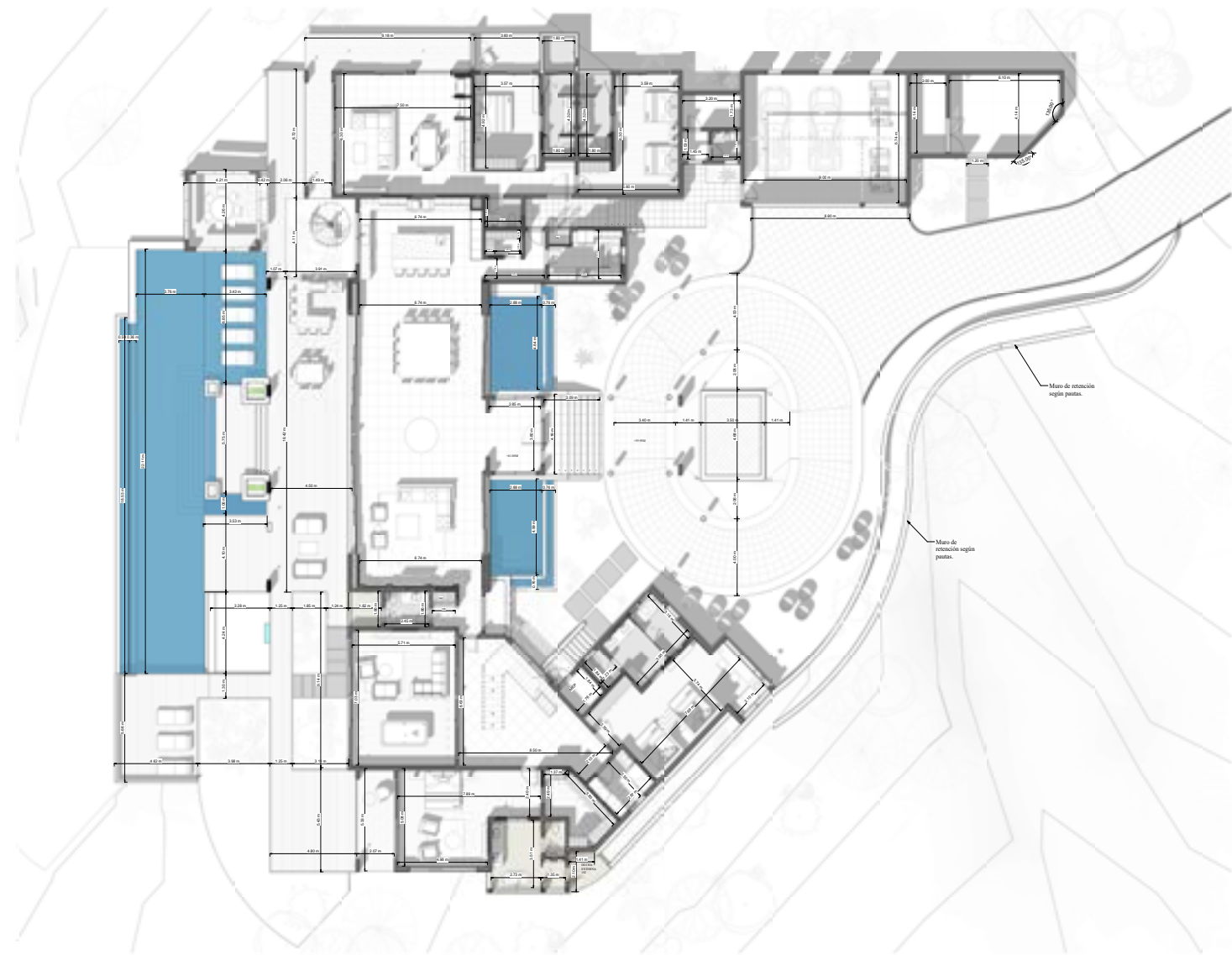

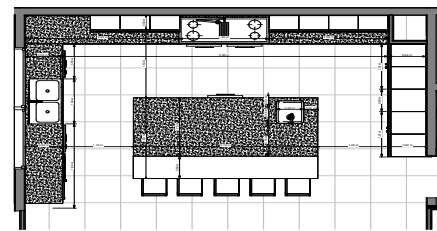

Blending clarity with mystery, the project offers a refined lifestyle rooted in modern design, where every space—open or hidden—invites a closer relationship with the natural environment.

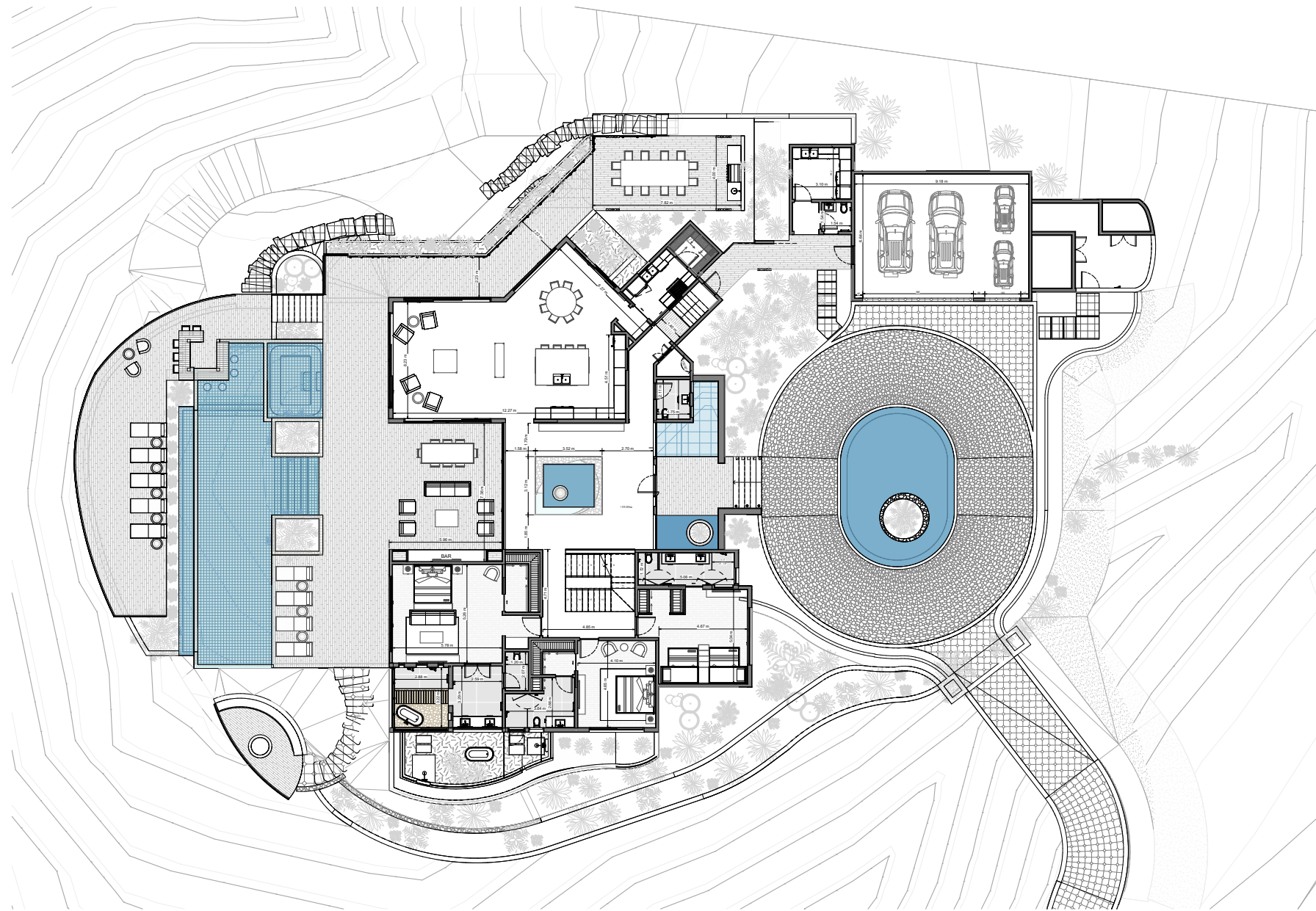

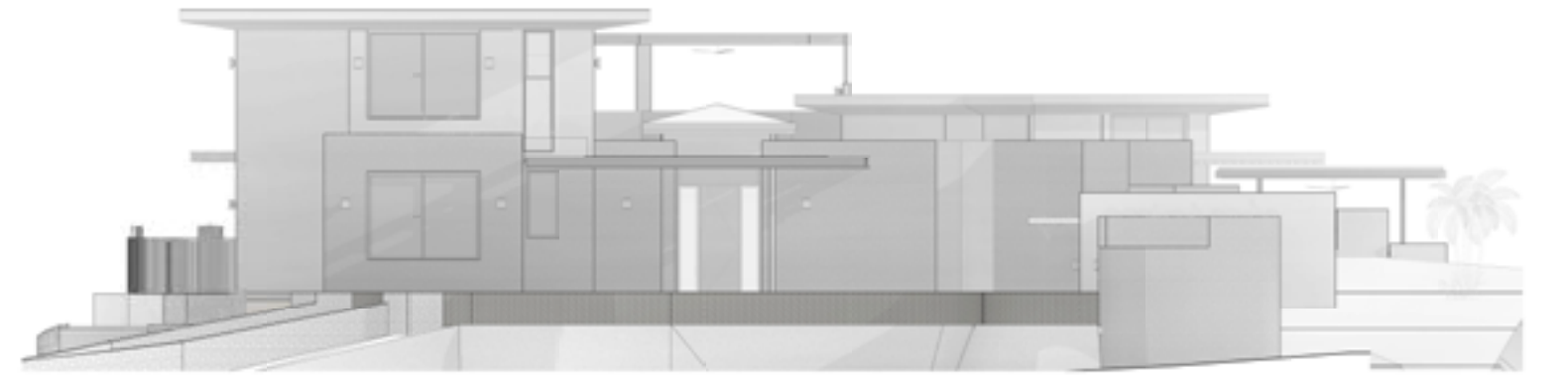

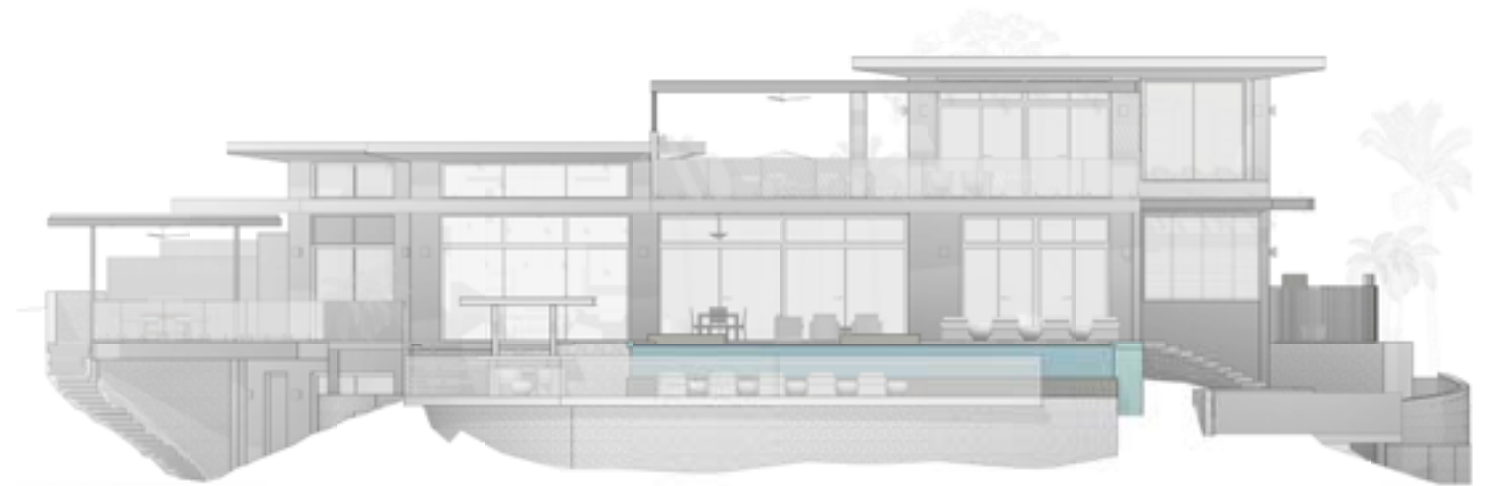




Floor Plan



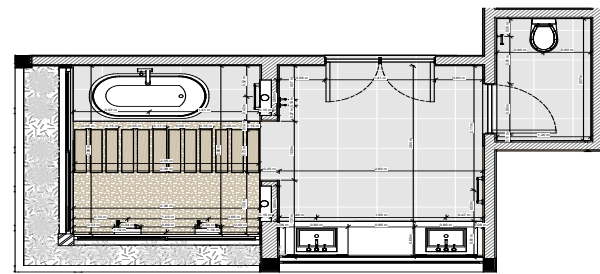

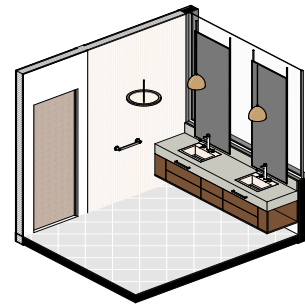

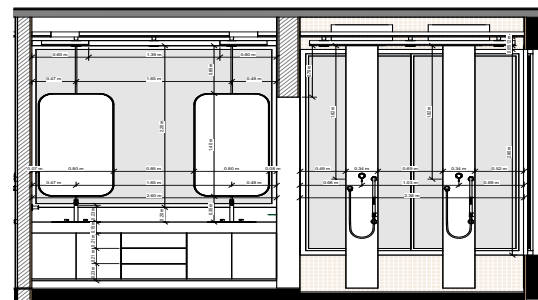

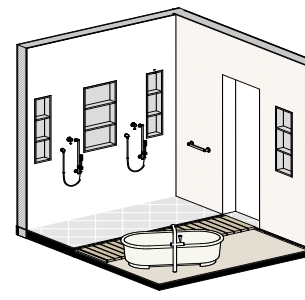
**Bathroom Floor Plan**
